Dear Members of the Class of 1983:

John Steinbeck wrote "...it is customary (indeed, at graduation it is a requirement) for speeches to refer to America as a precious inheritance." I do not mean to fill his requirements in this letter to you. My hope is that I can convey my feelings and, perhaps, Steinbeck's at graduation. If there is a truth I believe in, then it is probably that life and society run in cycles. Rigid discipline is the way it was when I was your age. Love, duty, respect for Mom and Dad, respect for the flag, and love for our country were the order of the day. Time has passed since I was a boy, and with no regret I watched the pendulum swing from strict discipline to a greater freedom of choice and then back to more and more accountability for what we say and, more importantly, for what we do.


Steinbeck also wrote that as Americans "...we are restless, dissatisfied, a searching people; we spend our time searching for security yet hate it when we get it." As Americans, we have been blessed with the simplicity and magnificence of freedom. Because we have so much, we constantly question our good fortune. Like the child at Christmas, we open our presents with a voracious appetite only to survey our world a few days later and ask, "Is that all there is?"

I do not know all that there is. I do know that we, you and I, have been blessed with many things these past few years. We have learned, laughed, and loved. We have experienced many happy times and a few that were sad. You have questioned us in so many of the things we have done. You are searching. You are rebellious. You are anxious. That anxiety surfaces in your enormous energy that wants to make things better. Steinbeck said, "Wasted energy is a little problem compared with the lack of it."

America will survive. We have the strength and restlessness of your youth. You have energy - use it! You have laughed - laugh again and again! You have loved - never stop!

Congratulations, good luck, and God bless you.







It is with great sorrow that the students of Huntington High School note the death of Dr. Paul Stillman in April of 1982.

He was a lifelong resident of Huntington attending Roosevelt Elementary School, Toaz Junior High School and Huntington High School.





BOY'S






GIRL'S




GIRLS' VARSITY BASKETBALL

Coach Heather Weiler has proved to be invaluable to them. Thanks to her love, talent, and, most of all, her motivation, they have had a successful season.




